## RULES and PROCEDURES

1. The application form can be found on the web site: [www.denverphilharmonic.org](http://www.denverphilharmonic.org)
2. Print and fill out the application form, enclose the \$30.00 fee and a VHS or DVD of your concerto performance, and mail to Myrna Jeong, 620 Emerson, Denver, 80218.
3. The above items must be received by October 22, 2010.. Any application received after October 22 will not be eligible; checks will be returned.

4. Each participant may perform only one movement of a concerto. The committee requests that standard repertoire be chosen. If there are any questions, please feel free to contact William Hinkie at 720-876-7665 or [Hinkieiii@netzero.net](mailto:Hinkieiii@netzero.net)
5. The age limits for application are as follows:

Lower Division

12 years to 18 years. Contestants must be at least 12 and no older than 18 by October 22, 2010.

Upper Division

19 years to 22 years

6. All contestants must be enrolled in an educational institution.
7. All performances must be accompanied. The contestant is responsible for his/her accompanist.
8. Contestants chosen for the next round of the competition will be notified by October 29, 2010.
9. The second round of the competition will consist of two master classes held on November 13, 2010 at KPOF Hall. Performers selected from the first round will be asked to perform in a public master class held at the following times:

Lower Division: 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

Upper Division: 10:45 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.

There will be a social hour with food and drink for contestants and guests after the conclusion of the master classes. There will be ample time to confer with the judges. Winners will be announced.

10. Winners perform with the Denver Philharmonic Orchestra on January 28, 2011 at KPOF Hall. The performance will be broadcast on KPOF radio.
11. The competition is open to Colorado residents only.
