

Announces auditions for: TRUMPET III

This is a volunteer membership position. Trumpet III musicians are expected to attend all rehearsals and concerts that call for the position. DPO performs seven to nine concerts over the September to May concert season with rehearsals primarily, but not exclusively, on Monday and Wednesday nights.

Please review the <u>2022-23 Schedule</u> to assess your availability to perform with the DPO before submitting an audition request.

AUDITION REPERTOIRE

1. First movement exposition of either Haydn or Hummel concerto in Eb (60 to 90 seconds)

- 2. Followed by the excerpts below, performed in order as shown
- Beethoven Leonore no. 3 (offstage solo, one call)
- Mussorgsky, opening promenade from Pictures at an exhibition (beginning to reh. 2, tpt 1)
- Stravinsky, Petrouchka (Ballerina's Dance, use 1947 version)
- Bizet, prelude to Carmen (tpt 1 in A)
- Handel (not Mozart), Trumpet Shall Sound (part is in C, play on instrument of your choice, excerpt is 28 bars plus pickups)
- Rimsky-Korsakov, Scheherezade mvt IV, C-D and T-U
- Brahms sym. 2, (mvt. 4: m. 397-429, tpt 1 in D). Rotary trumpet optional
- 3. Sight-reading may be requested
