1. Utilizing RTD Bus Route 8

RTD Bus Route 8 (Broadway Express) is a vital transportation link that connects Downtown Denver, the RiNo district, and the Mapleton Arts Center. Understanding how to effectively use this route will enhance your travel experience during your stay.

- Name: Bus Route 8 (Broadway Express)

 - o In-Person Kiosk Purchase tickets at a kiosk at Civic Center Station or Union Station.

Discounts:

- Seniors (65+), Persons with Disabilities, and Youth (6-17) may be eligible for discounted fares.
- o **Transfers**: Free transfers are available within two hours of the initial fare purchase.

How to Use Route 8

- 1. **Locate Your Nearest Stop**: Use Google Maps or the <u>RTD Denver website</u> to find the closest Route 8 bus stop to your hotel.
- 2. **Check the Schedule**: Verify bus times using the RTD Mobile Tickets app, Google Maps, or the RTD website to ensure timely departures.
- 3. Boarding the Bus:
 - o Wait at the Stop: Arrive at least 2 minutes before the scheduled arrival time.
 - Payment: Tap your contactless payment method or show your mobile ticket to the driver.

- Board the Bus: Enter through the front door and, if needed, indicate your stop to the driver.
- 4. **Disembarking**: Prepare to exit the bus as it approaches your destination by pressing the stop button in advance.
- 5. **Final Stop**: At **Mapleton Arts Center**, exit the bus and proceed to your destination.
